

Louis D'Arminio Jr. "Lee", of Hackensack, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at the age of 97. Prior to retiring, he owned with his brothers, D'Arminio & Son's Construction Company in Hackensack for many years. Lee was a proud veteran of WW II serving in the United States Army, where he was awarded the Purple Heart, Bronze Star and a Silver Star. He was a member of the VFW Post #8005 of South Hackensack, the American Legion Post #55 of Hackensack, and the last original
